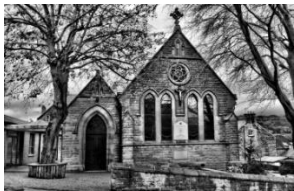

### CHRIST THE KING

A KINGSHIP THAT BEARS WITNESS TO THE TRUTH



The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB)

If to Christ our Lord is given all power in heaven and on earth; if all people, purchased by his precious blood, are by a new right subjected to his dominion; if this power embraces all people, it must be clear that not one of our faculties is exempt from his empire. He must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things and cleave to him alone. He must reign in our bodies and in our members, which should serve as instruments for the interior sanctification of our souls, or to use the words of the Apostle Paul, 'as instruments of justice unto God. – *Quas primas*, 33

The whole Church must work vigorously in order that all people may become capable of rectifying the distortion of the temporal order and directing it to God through Christ. Priests must clearly state the principles concerning the purpose of creation and the use of temporal things and must offer the moral and spiritual aids by which the temporal order may be renewed in Christ. The laity must take up the renewal of the temporal order as their own special obligation. [...]Everywhere and in all things they must seek the justice of God's kingdom. The temporal order must be renewed in such a way that, without detriment to its own proper laws, it may be brought into conformity with the higher principles of the Christian life and adapted to the shifting circumstances of time, place, and peoples. – *Apostolicam actuositatem*, 7

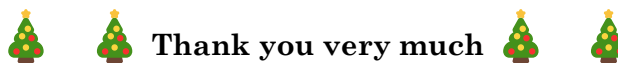


### Hassop Christmas Fair

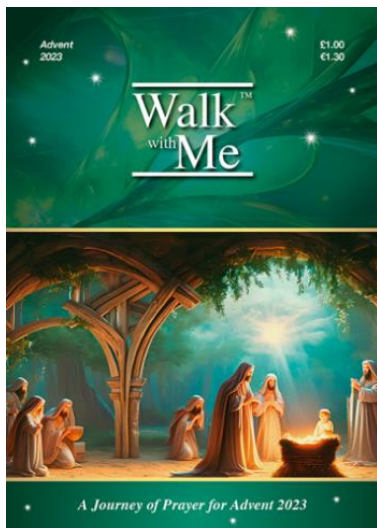

## Matlock - News for the Pews

**Poor and Needy Parishes** - there is retiring collection next weekend to provide for the support of poor and needy parishes which have difficulty in funding their needs which can be in relation to their buildings and community activities.

**DBS AND SAFER RECRUITMENT** - The Catholic Diocese of Nottingham requires DBS checks to be renewed every 3 years. The Diocese will only accept DBS certificates completed by other agencies if they are registered with the DBS Updating Service. There is an expectation that all clergy, readers, Church Wardens, and **all** PCC members and other Church Officers (paid or volunteers) who lead or help with children's or adults' activities, are DBS checked. The level of check will vary from a basic check to enhanced check depending on the role of the individual and their duties within the church. In response to this requirement may I respectfully ask that you check your DBS issue date and get in touch with me to renew if needed - alternatively DBS request forms will be left at the rear of church and can be handed to Father Robbie in an envelope labelled for the attention of Caroline Rodgers.
