Message from Pope Francis on your First Holy Communion Day

“Dear boys and girls, you have come here to take part in a wonderful celebration. I am sure you will never forget this day: your first encounter with Jesus in the sacrament of the Eucharist.

We rejoice because, for love of us, Jesus gave his life on the cross and destroyed sin. He rose again and made us adopted sons and daughters of God the Father. We are joyful because he is alive and present among us, today and always.

One of you might ask me: How can we meet Jesus? He lived a long time ago, but then he died and was laid in the tomb! It is true: Jesus carried out an immense act of love to save human beings of all times. He remained in the tomb for three days, but we know—the Apostles and many other witnesses who saw him alive have assured us—that God, his Father and ours, raised him up. Now Jesus is alive and is here with us. That is why we can encounter him today in the Eucharist. We do not see him with our physical eyes, but we do see him with the eyes of faith.”

Corpus Christi - This feast is celebrated in the Latin Church on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday to solemnly commemorate the institution of the Holy Eucharist. Maundy Thursday, which commemorates this great event, mention is made as *Natalis Calicis* (Birth of the Chalice) in the Calendar of Polemius (448) for the 24th of March, the 25th of March being in some places considered as the day of the death of Christ. This day, however, was in Holy Week, a season of sadness, during which the minds of the faithful are expected to be occupied with thoughts of the Lord's Passion

First Holy Communion Day - This Sunday - 11th June at 11am

My advice for this Sunday is that if you can move your Mass attendance to the Saturday Vigil Matlock or Sunday at All Saints, Hassop you will avoid the crowds. If you can't, then I would recommend arriving early as half the church will have reserved seating for the children and their families.
