Jesus provides us. We appreciate and are open to your willingness to **GIVE** of your time; treasure and talent.

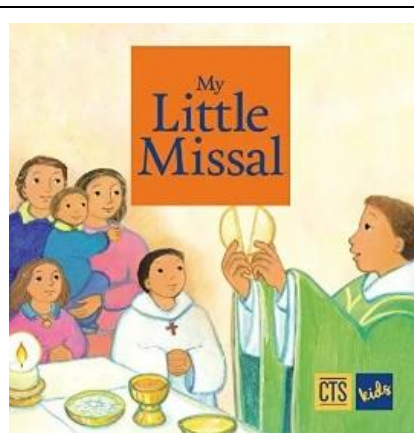
