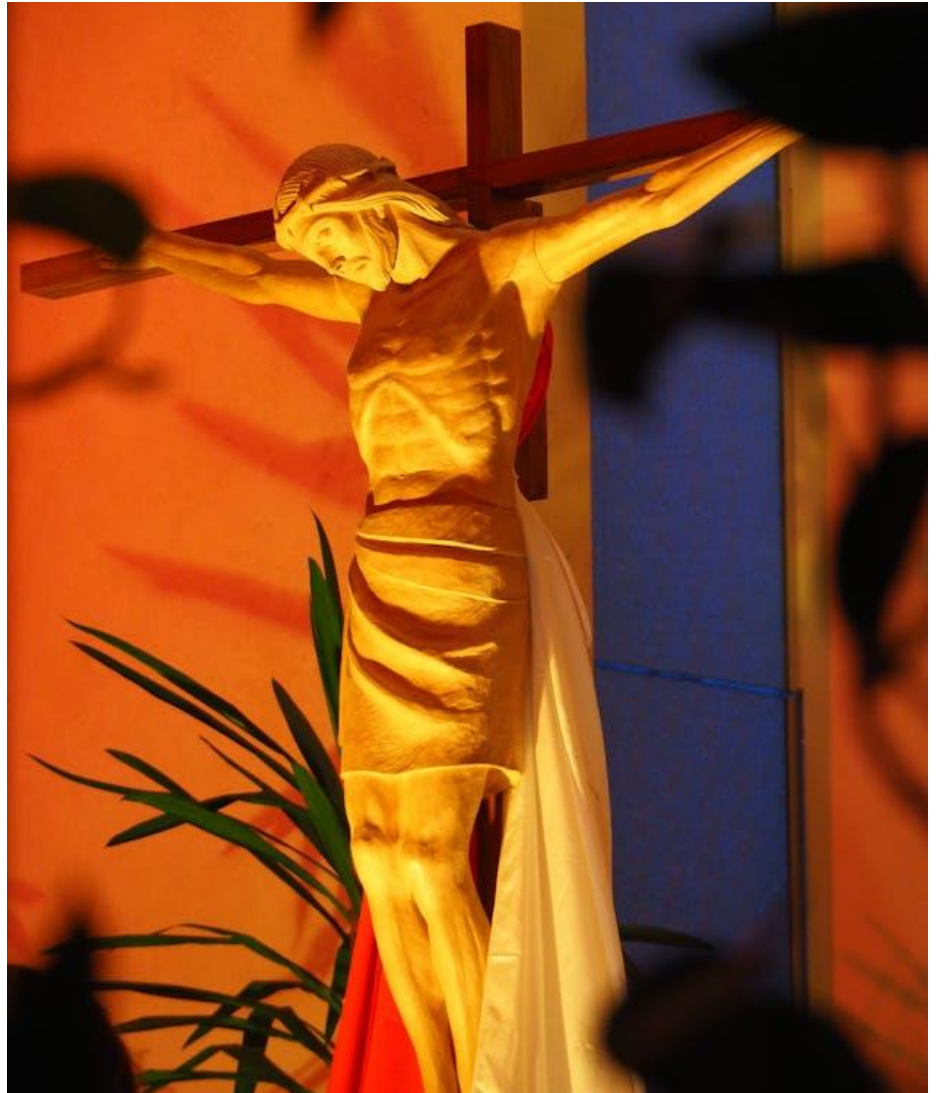

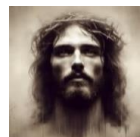

Most of us need that kind of environment in order to be in touch with God and to listen to His voice, especially the interior voice.

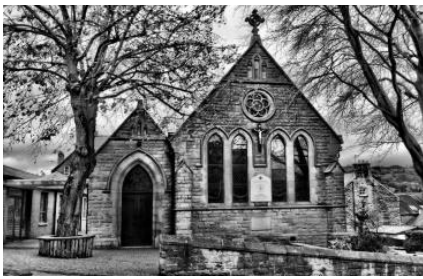

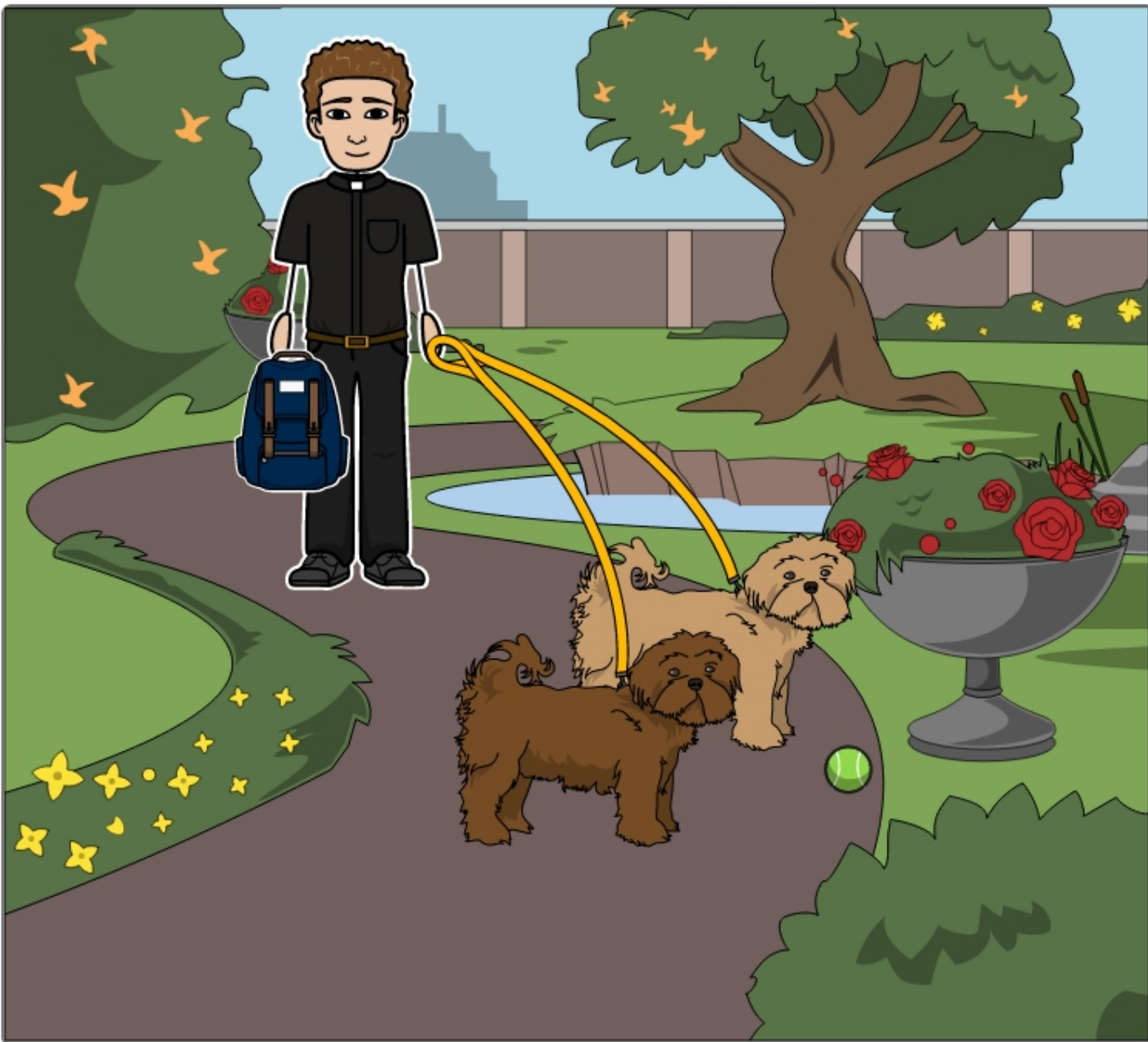
