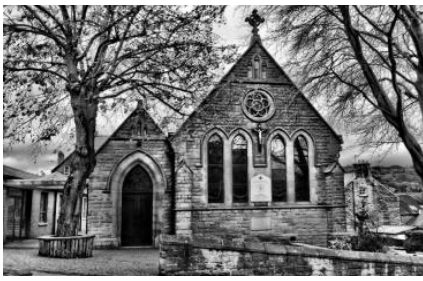

For those who are Baptised and have received their First Holy Communion, one further *Sacrament of Initiation* enables them to commit to their faith wholeheartedly. We hope you feel you are ready to take this step.
