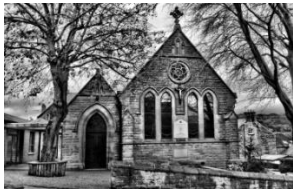

To another man Jesus asked the pointed question, “Do you want to be healed?”

The greatest good we can do for others is not by giving them money, though that can also be needed at times, but in revealing their own riches to them. It is good to affirm others and make them feel both loved and worthwhile. Many people have grown up with a poor self-image, and they just cannot see the good in themselves. This is another form of blindness, and it is a blindness in others that any one of us can heal. The most certain proof that the Spirit of God lives in you is your willingness and ability to affirm and bring a blessing to other people.

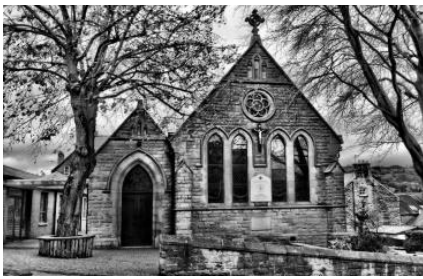

The Warm Space at our parish hall has been very successful this Winter due to the efforts of the volunteers and all those in the parish who have made donations – either groceries, books, toys and games and money.

We have been part of the Churches Together in Matlock town project to provide a welcome, warmth, company and refreshment. We have also been recognised by our town Mayor, Paul Cruise, with a civic award for our contribution to the community.

The Warm Space provision in the hall will come to an end on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> April.

The team involved with the Warm Space have decided to keep the facility going through the warmer months in the form of a 'drop-in' – open and accessible to anyone in the community, including our own parishioners.

It will continue to run on a Monday, starting on 17<sup>th</sup> April between 11am and 2 pm, offering an unconditional welcome, friendship, company, conversation and free refreshments.
