We had a formative preparation with parishioners speaking to the Candidates about their own life and faith journey and these were inspirational – Baptism, prayer, our talents, commitment, Reconciliation, etc. – all beautifully thought out and delivered. The Bishop has acknowledged that All Saints, though a small parish, has an active community of its own and therefore requires dedicated ministry to embrace and support its parishioners. The Bishop has therefore amended the proposed Mass times post-July to ensure Fr Robbie is able to socialise and spend time with us after Mass before leaving for Matlock. The new Mass times as requested by the Bishop are therefore as follows:
