Message from Fr Hugh...

Last Wednesday we celebrated the feast to honour St Thomas More and St John Fisher. On Sunday 10th July we resume our Padley Pilgrimage: it is our nearest local pilgrimage gathering and it is shared by both Nottingham and Hallam Dioceses.

The Padley Pilgrimage recalls the arrest of 2 priests who had been betrayed and were apprehended in Padley Manor (very close to Grindleford station). The annual martyrs walk at Padley is made in memory of Nicholas Garlick and Robert Ludlum who were Catholic priests discovered at Padley when exercising their priesthood to a small group of the faithful in 1588. This was the year of the Spanish Armada and there were fears of invasion by hostile Catholic forces, so the government took a harsh stance and the 2 priests were executed for treason at Derby. The pilgrimage commemorates their bravery by a short walk followed by Mass at the chapel. They became known as the 'Padley Martyrs'. The Manor was owned by the Fitzherbert family and John was imprisoned and died in 1590. Sir Thomas Fitzherbert spent 32 years in prison for his faith and died in the Tower of London in 1591. Padley Manor was confiscated by the Crown before being returned later to the Fitzherbert family.

Next Wednesday (29th) we celebrate the Holy Day in honour of SS Peter & Paul and, in a sense, this feast day connects us to the martyrdom of the Padley priests plus SS John Fisher and Thomas More because everything goes back to the Apostolic Tradition which we shall be reminded of during the Preface. So, let's indeed come together to honour the two apostles who are the foundation stone of Christ's Church. **Fr Hugh**
