Sanctuary Lamp – Repose of the soul of John Lovett

Pope Francis - will spend all three days in Hungary from April 28th to 30th. Whilst in the capital, Budapest, Pope Francis, will meet political leaders, diplomats, priests and nuns, and intellectuals, as well as with poor people and refugees. The Pope, who made a brief stop in Budapest on his way to Slovakia in 2021, will preside at an open-air Mass in Kossuth Lajos Square on Sunday, April 30th.

During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully.

We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began **new life in Christ**.

The name, **Cathedra**, refers to the Latinized Greek term for "the seat of a bishop". This is where the word Cathedral comes from.

Lent is a season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving - that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter.

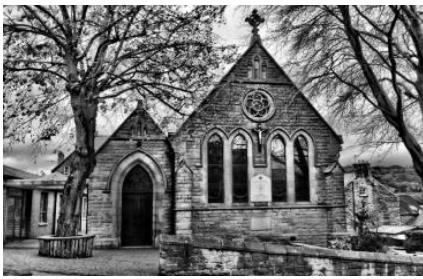

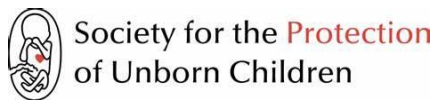

The word Lent - is derived from the Anglo-Saxon word lencten, meaning spring. How appropriate for this Lenten season as we emerge from the darkness of this past year of pandemic. Hope, healing and, maybe just as importantly, a rebuilding of community... our faithful community, has begun. **A new spring has arrived.**

One of the most common Lenten practices is "**giving something up,**" a way to make a small self-sacrifice in order to unite with the sacrifice that Jesus made for us on the Cross. But think about it. When we give up something, we're also creating more room inside ourselves - more room for Jesus to live in our hearts.

Let us meditate on Jesus' great sacrifice and reflect on what we have surrendered this Holy Lenten Season.
