






#### Pentecost Sunday





The opening of Our Lady & St Joseph Church in the Daytime It is with pleasure that I have decided to reopen the church at Matlock during the daytime for private prayer (It has been closed since Covid outside of Mass/Liturgy times). The new opening times will be from 7.00am until 7.00pm (Spring/Summer) and 9.00am until 6.00pm (Autumn/Winter) Tuesdays to Sundays (Closed Mondays) This will require a temporary barrier and an extra camera for the sanctuary. Both cameras in the church will be fed through to the parish office and Fr Robbie's mobile phone. Candles and Book Stands will be removed at the end of each Mass and those next to the Tabernacle are already chained to the wall. I hope this will allow many of you when you are visiting the town to once again be able to pop in and say some prayers. Votive Candles will not be available due to non-direct supervision of the area and the risk of vandalism through fire. I can't always guarantee the heating will be on, but I shall set it for lunchtime each day. Please know that all parishioners are most welcome when you're passing to pray in our beautiful church.
